## Tsinghua International School





Tsinghua International School (THIS)'s mission is to foster creative critical thinkers rooted in China who are prepared to lead in the global community. We aim to develop the whole child utilizing constructivist pedagogies and nurture individuals of exceptional character to positively contribute to the world. The school's core values are: wellbeing, innovation, leadership, collaboration, respect, and integrity.



A hallmark of THIS is the requirement that students undertake advanced study in both English and Chinese language.

The school's primary language of instruction is English, and students take all regular courses in English.

In Chinese language, we offer courses for both first- and second-language speakers, denoted on the transcript with "A" and "B" respectively. For students who are native speakers of Chinese, the curriculum is similar to that in a Chinese national school, with advanced work in history and literature to develop reading, writing, and public speaking skills.



THIS follows an American curriculum including 16 AP courses and 2 University Level (UL) courses. In addition to our core courses, we also offer 20+ elective courses annually across various disciplines. The UL courses are Intro to Linear Algebra and Multivariable Calculus, designed for Grades 11 and 12 students.

### **AP Courses Allowed**

CURRICULUM Students may take a maximum of 8 AP courses and 2 UL courses over four years. AP Chinese is excluded from this limit, and the two-year AP Art and Design course counts as one course. In some cases, students may appeal to the academic principal to exceed this maximum.

Grade 12 students are eligible to participate in an independent study course at school if they are on track for graduation, achieve a minimum GPA of 3.25, and identify an area in which they wish to study in depth.

## STUDY

INDEPENDENT The student works with a teacher to develop their area of interest for the year, and meets regularly to focus on research and project development. At the end of the school year, students present their research or project to school faculty.



Through this program, students will have the chance to work closely with experienced mentors from top universities and research institutes in China, learn valuable research skills, and gain practical experience in their areas of interest.

## RESEARCH **MENTORING PROGRAM**

The program, established in 2021, aims to provide mentorship and guidance to students interested in pursuing research projects across various fields. Each academic year, we recruit students in the spring. Currently, we have 31 mentors and 43 high school students participating in this program in below fields:


